Foundation Removal Mocksville, North Carolina

Air Compressor Factory Mocksville, North Carolina. Project involved fracturing and removal of concrete foundations that were under floor in the plant. Vibration and dust were of high concern. Contractor used rock drills, with water dust control, to drill the holes. Rebar was spaced on 1 foot centers. Holes were drilled on 1 foot centers to ease drilling. There was no vertical steel in the foundations. Once fractured, an excavator was able to shake the foundations apart and remove them.
